CHILDREN'S SYSTEM OF CARE

CSOC network of supports and services are available to ANY New Jersey child, youth or young adult (5-21) and their family, who is experiencing behavioral health, intellectual/developmental or substance use challenges.

CSOC PARTNERS HELP NEW JERSEY YOUTH BE SAFE * HEALTHY * CONNECTED

CARE MANAGEMENT ORGANIZATION Manage * Stabilize * Link

Through the development of a Child and Family Team (CFT) and the use of the Wraparound Model, each youth and family is supported by a team of family members, professionals and community residents, identified by the family and organized by the Care Manager.

MOBILE RESPONSE

De-escalate * Assess Crisis Planning & Linking

Mobile Response and Stabilization Services are available 24/7, to help children and youth who are experiencing emotional or behavioral crises. The services are designed to defuse an immediate crisis, keep children and their families safe, and maintain the children in their own homes or current living situation in the community.

FAMILY SUPPORT ORGANIZATION Support * Educate * Advocate

Family Support Organizations (FSO) provide direct family-to-family peer support, education, advocacy, and other supports, to help them navigate the System of Care, school system, DCP&P, and the legal system, and most importantly are there to listen and provide moral support.

INTENSIVE IN-HOME SERVICES

Individualized * Solution-Focused Family-Centered

Intensive In-Community Service (IIC) address emotional and behavioral challenges of youth with the goal of stabilizing and supporting the youth and family, and to deter more intensive interventions.

OUT OF HOME TREATMENT

Intensive * Therapeutically Supportive * Short Term

They're residential treatment programs that provide 24/7 care and treatment for children, youth, and young adults who require the highest intensity of services.





CHILD WELFARE

CARE MANAGEMENT ORGANIZATION

87% of children receiving CSOC care management were able to receive treatment and supportive interventions while remaining at home with their families.

PREVENTION & COMMUNITY SERVICES

Family Success Centers support over 31,000 families, providing 43,000 referrals for families, approximately 20,000 sessions on life skills, and nearly 16,000 session on advocacy.

JUVENILE JUSTICE

FAMILY SUPPORT ORGANIZATION

Participants in Family Support Organizations noted that the caring and supportive relationships they formed with workers and mentors created the conditions for positive change.

CHILDREN SYSTEM OF CARE

MOBILE RESPONSE

97% of children and youth receiving Mobile Response and Stabilization Services remained at home with their families.
