Problematic Sexualized Behaviors (PSB): Definition and Program Overview

Topic: Psychoeducation on what sexualized behaviors are considered problematic in children and adolescents. Through the specialized care coordinator (SCC), children who initiate or are affected by PSB, and their families, have access to specialized medical and mental health services. These services are at no cost to families through New Jersey Children's Alliance (NJCA).

CALM: Counseling on Access to Lethal Means

Topic: CALM is a suicide prevention workshop that equips participants with the knowledge and tools to reduce the risk of self-harm or suicide by limiting access to lethal means during times of crisis.

Duration: 3 hours for clinicians, 1 hour (CALM Conversations for general public)

Target audience: Full workshop: Clinicians, mental health providers
CALM Conversations: Parents, Community Organizations, Schools, etc.

Triple P: Positive Parenting Program

Topic: evidence-based workshop that helps parents strengthen relationships, encourage positive behavior, and manage challenges calmly. It offers practical, adaptable strategies for everyday parenting. Families leave feeling more confident, supported, and connected

Duration: 2 hours

Target Audience: Parents, Schools, Community Organizations, Medical/Substance Use/Mental Health Professionals

Triple P: Extensions

Topic: Focused, small-group sessions designed for parents who seek support around specific behavioral or developmental challenges, adapting the framework to work with families with adolescents or parents of young children experiencing clinically significant anxiety
