WHEN TO REFER

- Ongoing emotional, behavioral or social concerns.
- School avoidance/refusal, aggression withdrawal, or unsafe behaviors.
- Trauma, loss, bullying, or major life changes.
- Developmental or substance use concerns affecting daily life.



HOW TO GET CONNECTED

- 1 The legal guardian must call **PerformCare** at **1-877-652-7624**
- 2 Youth age 18+ must call for themselves
- 3 Help the family describe what is happening, including specific examples and concerns
- 4 If helpful, offer a quiet space, or support while making the call

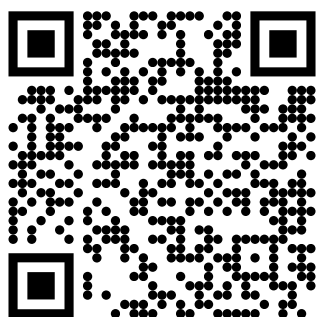


WHAT INFORMATION HELPS

- Specific behaviors or concerns that are happening
- How often and how long they last
- Impact at home, school and in the community
- Safety concerns or crisis history
- Stressors such as trauma, grief, bullying or major changes
- Services or supports already tried
